Switch off the charger Switch off the charger or check if the charger has been switched off. Disconnect the charger. Disconnect EC, if connected. Check final values if applicable.



Equalizing charge Carry out weekly equalizing charge.

Measure cell voltages



Measure electrolyte specific gravities and temperature If over 45°C, leave to cool down.



Measure insulation value Must be at least 50 Ω per V of nominal voltage.



Clean the battery Clean the battery and extract liquid from inside the container!



Exchange aeromatic filter Check air pump function.



Request Service department If significant changes from earlier measurements or differences between the cells are found, request further testing and maintenance by the Service department.
